Exceptional Rider: Classes open to riders currently enrolled in a therapeutic horsemanship program. Division A riders to have a horse handler and side walkers/spotters as necessary. Division B riders to be semi-independent with or without spotters (to have at least 1 coach enter the arena with entry for safety). Division C to be independent with coaches in the arena. Exceptional rider instructors/coaches welcome to stand in center of show arena for rider support.

Classes 15 – 29: Classes have been grouped for horse availability and rider ability.

Timed games: Riders will be penalized 5 seconds for breaking into the canter.

All classes open to both English and Western riders. Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined. Divisions will accumulate points towards year end awards. Participation in all shows not required to accumulate points. Points will be posted on Manito website within 2 weeks after the final show. Year-end champion and reserve champion will be awarded at our year-end award ceremony. Date and location to be announced. There will be no day end division championships awarded, points will be accumulated toward year-end championships only. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st place – 7 points, 2nd place – 5 points, 3rd place – 4 points, 4th place – 3 points, 5th place – 2 points, 6th place – 1 point. Points will be accumulated per rider regardless of the horse ridden. Age of rider to be determined as of 12/1/2016.

Exceptional Rider Division B – Class 2 and 5
Exceptional Rider Division C – Class 3 and 6
Exceptional Rider Speed Events – Class 7 and 8
Lead Line Walk 10 & Under – Class 11 and 12
Lead Line Walk Trot 10 & Under – Class 13 and 14
Walk Trot Division A – Class 15, 16, and 17
Walk Trot Division B – Class 18, 19, and 20
Walk Trot Division C – Class 21, 22, and 23
Walk Trot Novice Adult – Class 24, 25, and 26
Walk Trot Adult – Class 27, 28, and 29
Walk Trot Games Division – Class 30, 31, and 32

There will also be a year-end champion for fitting and showmanship awarded for both Manito Life Center as well as Manito Equestrian Center.

Attire should be neat, clean, and workman like. Boots, SEI certified helmets, and appropriate riding pants required for all mounted activities. Proper show attire recommended, but not required. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated in or out of the arena. A family friendly schooling show atmosphere to be maintained at all times. No trotting outside of the arena. Warm up is permitted in designated areas only.

Horses must present proof of negative Coggins within 6 months prior to unloading. This is a fun and educational show series. All levels of rider and disciplines welcomed. **No Stallions permitted.**
